A SUPPLEMENT

To an act incorporating the president, managers and company, of the Lancaster, Elizabethtown and Middletown turnpike road.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Lancaster, Elizabethtown and Middletown turnpike road company, shall be authorized to hold their annual election for president, managers and treasurer, on the first Monday in January, in each year hereafter. *Provided nevertheless,* That the said company shall be authorized in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, to hold their election for president, managers and treasurer at the time now provided for by law, whose term of office shall continue until the next annual election thereafter, or till otherwise legally superseded by said company, and that so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as is inconsistent herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed.
