AN ACT;

Further to amend an act to incorporate the Pennsylvania and Ohio Canal
 Company.

Assent to the
 provisions of
 an act of
 state of Ohio

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted, by the Senate and House of
 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in
 General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the au-
 thority of the same,* That the full and entire assent of this
 commonwealth be, and the same is hereby given to all
 and each of the provisions mentioned and contained in an act
 of the legislature of the state of Ohio, passed on the twenty-
 ninth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-
 seven, being an act further to amend an act incorporating the
 Pennsylvania and Ohio canal company, and the said amenda-
 tory act is hereby adopted, ratified, and confirmed, and enacted
 into a law of this commonwealth, and all and each of the

provisions, conditions, and restrictions thereof, as fully and effectually as if the same were re-enacted paragraph by paragraph, and section by section, so far as the same can apply to this commonwealth.

SECTION 2. An exemplified copy of said amendatory act of the state of Ohio shall be annexed to this act, and published in the same manner as this act shall be published; and the governor of this commonwealth shall cause an attested copy of this act to be transmitted to the governor of Ohio, for the use of that state. Exemplified

AN ACT further to amend an act incorporating the Pennsylvania and Ohio Canal Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio,* That the board of directors of the Pennsylvania and Ohio canal company, shall consist of nine members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

SECTION 2. That it shall be lawful for any subscriber or stockholder of said company to transfer on the books of the company, in the manner prescribed by the by-laws, any stock standing in his or her name, on which thirty dollars on each share shall have been paid, and the person or persons so accepting such transfer, shall thereafter become a member of said company, and subject to all the liabilities of an original subscriber, for the payment of any instalments which may then remain due, or which may be subsequently required.

SECTION 3. That the board of directors shall have the power of declaring any stock to be forfeited to the company, on which three or more instalments shall have become due and unpaid, by giving at least thirty days notice of their intention to do so, either to the person in whose name such stock may stand on the books of the company, or by publishing such intention in one or more newspapers printed, or in general circulation, in the place where such stockholder resides, and the stock thus declared forfeited, shall from thenceforth be vested in said company: *Provided,* That such forfeiture shall not effect the rights or liabilities of any other stockholder than the one whose shares shall be so forfeited, and in that case, only to the amount of stock declared forfeited.

AN ACT

To authorize the Governor to subscribe for stock to the companies for erecting bridges over the river Susquehanna, at the towns of Danville and Northumberland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the governor of this commonwealth is hereby authorized and required to subscribe for two hundred shares in the stock of the company for erecting a bridge over the river Susquehanna at the town of Danville, to be expended in procuring the necessary materials, and towards making the repairs to the said bridge.

SECTION 2. That the governor of this commonwealth, is hereby authorized and required to subscribe ten thousand dollars, to the stock of the Northumberland bridge company, to be expended in procuring the necessary materials for rebuilding the bridge across the North Branch of the river Susquehanna, at the town of Northumberland, in the county of Northumberland.
