AN ACT

To revive and amend an act, entitled "An act to authorize the Sandy and Beaver canal company, to extend a canal into Pennsylvania, passed the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight"

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all the provisions of the act entitled "an act to authorize the Sandy and Beaver canal company, to extend a canal into Pennsylvania," passed the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, be, and the same are hereby revived, and continued in full force, subject to the limitations and amendments hereinafter set forth

Powers of Sandy and Beaver canal continued

SECTION 2. That the said canal company are hereby authorized and empowered, to make an outlet lock, or locks, into the river Ohio, at the termination of the said canal, and at, or near the mouth of the Little Beaver creek in the state of Pennsylvania, and so much of the said act, to extend the Sandy and Beaver canal into Pennsylvania, as requires the said canal company to continue the canal from a point, at or near the mouth of Little Beaver creek, up the valley of the Ohio to the vicinity of the mouth of the Big Beaver creek be and the same is hereby repealed. *Provided,* That nothing contained in this act shall be construed to prevent the state of Pennsyl-

vania from constructing a canal from the mouth of the Big Beaver, to the termination of the Sandy and Beaver canal, at or near the mouth of the Little Beaver, or to effect, or in anywise impair the rights of this state to the water power at the mouth of the Big Beaver, and in case of the construction of the said canal between the Little Beaver and the Big Beaver aforesaid, either by the said company or the state of Pennsylvania, the connexion with the state canal shall be made under the supervision of an agent to be appointed by the canal commissioners, and at the expense of said company.

Power to borrow money

SECTION 3. The directors or managers of the said company shall have power and authority to borrow in the corporate name thereof, from individuals or bodies corporate such sums of money as may be necessary for the completion and repair of the said canal, and the shares of stock in the said company shall be transferrable on the books of the said company and by such agents as they may appoint for that purpose, as the stock of other companies incorporated by the laws of this commonwealth.

Relative to water of Big Beaver

SECTION 4. The said company shall at no time take or cause to be taken any portion of the waters of the Big Beaver, for the supply of the canal or other purposes, without the consent first had, and obtained of the state of Pennsylvania.

Time for completion extended

SECTION 5. The said company shall be allowed twenty years from the passage of the act incorporating the said company to complete said canal, any thing in said act to the contrary notwithstanding.
