AN ACT

To authorize the commissioners of York county to pay over certain moneys to the teachers of schools in the township of Hellam, and borough of Wrightsville.

Preamble

WHEREAS, The commissioners of the county of York, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven, assessed and collected a tax from the inhabitants of the township of Hellam, and the borough of Wrightsville in said township, and county aforesaid, for the education of such poor children whose parents were unable to pay for their schooling, the general system of education being accepted by said township and borough aforesaid, being then one district, but the same never has been put into operation, and there being no law to authorize the commissioners to pay the teachers of said children out of the money collected as aforesaid. Therefore,

Commissioners to settle accounts of teachers of poor children

To pay over to teachers the tax assessed and collected

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the county of York shall immediately after the passing of this act, settle the accounts of the teachers of schools within the township of Hellam and borough of Wrightsville in the county of York, for teaching the children of said township and borough, whose parents were unable to pay for their schooling, and for stationary furnished for the use of said children between the first day of February, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven, and the first day of February, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, and pay to the said teachers the amount of the tax which had been assessed and collected of the said township of Hellam, and borough of Wrightsville, according to the rule provided in the act, entitled, an act to provide for the education of the poor, gratis, for ascertaining the sum to be due to such teachers respectively; and in case of any remaining, the said commissioners shall pay the same to the school directors of the said township of Hellam, and borough of Wrightsville, agreeably to the present law establishing a general system of education.
