

second, third, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth, eleventh, and twelfth, sections of said law. *Provided*, That the acts and things directed by said sections to be done, and situated in the county of Luzerne, shall be done and situated in Dauphin and Schuylkill counties. *And provided further*, That said company shall have power to borrow any sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, and convert the same into certificates of capital stock, if the same shall be deemed necessary. Only two hundred thousand dollars issued, capital stock, to be employed in the mining of coal, and transporting the same to market, the balance to be exclusively employed in the construction of the necessary railroads and other improvements.

SECTION 2. This act shall be and continue in force until the first day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine. *Provided*, That it shall be lawful for the legislature, at any time, to amend or repeal any of the foregoing provisions, and to rescind any of the powers hereby granted. *And provided further*, That this act shall cease to be in force, unless some railroad contemplated by this act, shall be commenced within three years and completed within seven years, from the passage of this act.

## AN ACT

For the better preservation of certain species of Game in the county of Adams and Dauphin.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That from and after the first day of April next, no person shall kill in the counties of Adams and Dauphin, any woodcock, between the first day of February and the twentieth day of June; nor any wild turkey, pheasant, &c. within certain periods

ant, nor partridge, between the fifteenth day of January and the first day of September, of each and every year thereafter.

**Eggs or nests not to be destroyed** SECTION 2. No person shall at any time wilfully destroy the eggs, or nests, of any wild turkey, pheasant, partridge, or woodcock, within the said counties.

**Purchase and sale prohibited out of season** SECTION 3. No carrier, huckster, victualler, or innkeeper, shall have in his or her possession, or buy or cause to be bought, or carry out of the said counties for the purpose of supplying any market, any wild turkey, pheasant, partridge, nor woodcock, unless they shall have been taken in the proper season.

**Penalty for violation of this act** SECTION 4. Any person or persons, offending against any of the provisions of this act, on conviction thereof, before any justice of the peace, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence, a fine of five dollars, and all costs and charges, one half of the fine for the use of the informer. and the other half for the use of the counties respectively.

## AN ACT

Supplemental to an act incorporating the Warren County Mutual Insurance Company.

**Directors to receive subscriptions of stock** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That for the purpose of extending the powers and objects of the Warren County Mutual Insurance Company, the present board of directors of said company are hereby authorized to receive subscriptions for a capital stock to consist of five thousand shares of fifty dollars each, the payments for which shall be called in at such times and in such instalments as the said board or their successors may direct, and subject to such penalties for the non-
