AN ACT

For the relief of Samuel R. Richards, a contractor on the Kiskeminetas and Conemaugh Division of the Pennsylvania Canal.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners be, and they are hereby required to re-examine and settle the accounts and claims of Samuel R. Richards, for work done on guard-lock number three, and lift-lock number four, and dam number three, and section number seventy-nine on the Kiskeminetas and Conemaugh division of the Pennsylvania canal; and also to re-examine and settle with said Samuel R. Richards for work in removing a hill slip above guard-lock number three, and lift-lock number four, on said line of canal, and to pay him any balance which may be due him for said work, after deducting any sum or sums he may have already received therefor.
