A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to incorporate the Susquehanna Canal Company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Susquehanna canal company is hereby authorized so to alter and construct the lower breast of the dam, across the river near Columbia, and also, that of the dam proposed to be built near the mouth of the Conestoga, as will render the said dams secure and permanent: *Provided,* That the said dams shall not be raised higher than now allowed by law; also, to adjust and regulate the form and breadth of the schutes in the said dams, as will render them safe for the passage of crafts of all kinds. That the said alterations shall be made under the same restrictions and liabilities, as regards damages which may be occasioned thereby, as is now provided for by the existing laws incorporating and conferring powers upon said company.
