## SUPPLEMENT

To an act incorporating the Columbia and Maryland Line Railroad Company.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That so much of the first section of the act entitled, "an act incorporating the Columbia and Maryland line railroad company," passed the fourth day of April, A. D. eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, as fixes the time for the opening of books for the subscription to the stock of said company, be so altered as to give the commissioners therein named the power of opening said books at any time they may see proper, previously to the first of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five.

Time of opening books extended

**SECTION 2.** That the time allowed for the commencement and completion of said work, be extended five years from the time mentioned in the act to which this is a supplement, that is to say, to the fourth of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, for the commencement, and to the fourth of April, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, for the completion of said road.
