## RESOLUTION

Authorizing the State Treasurer to pay certain expenses incurred by the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

*RESOLVED, By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met.* That the state treasurer be authorized to pay, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, the expenses that may arise in carrying into effect a resolution passed the sixteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, directing the secretary of the commonwealth to make enquiries of the assessors of every ward, township, and district in the commonwealth, on the subject of agriculture, manufactures and commerce.
