To authorize the Canal Commissioners to inquire into and adjust the
 claim of Peter Stehman.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives
 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assem-
 bly met*, That the canal commissioners are hereby authorized
 and required to inquire into the claim for damages sustained
 by Peter Stehman, transporter of merchandize on the Phila-
 delphia and Columbia railroad, in consequence of the breaking
 of the rope on the inclined plane near Philadelphia, by which
 accident it is alleged his cars were broken and destroyed, and
 to report the amount of damages, if any, and pay the same
 out of the damage fund, and the said payment shall be allow-
 ed by the auditor general as in other cases.
