## RESOLUTIONS

Authorizing the electors of the borough of Blairville, in Indiana county, to hold their elections in room No. one, in the new school house, and changing the time for holding elections in the borough of Hollidaysburg; and, also, providing for holding elections in the township of Jackson, in the county of Columbia.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met,* That the electors of the borough of Blairville, in the county of Indiana, shall hereafter hold their elections for borough officers and school directors, at room No. one, in the new school house, recently erected in said borough. RESOLVED, That from and after the passage of this act, the time fixed by law for holding the borough elections, in the borough of Hollidaysburg, shall be changed from the thirteenth day of September, to the third Friday in March, provided that the borough officers now elected shall continue in office until the third Friday in March, one thousand eight hundred and forty. RESOLVED, That from and after the passage of this act, the qualified electors of Jackson township, in the county of Columbia, shall hold their township elections at the house of Joshua Savage, of said township, and until otherwise directed by the provisions of the first section of the act of April, one thousand eight hundred and seven.
