RESOLUTION

To provide for the removal of the trial of an indictment pending in Court of Oyer and Terminer, of the county of Bucks.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,* That a certain indictment found in the court of oyer and terminer, of Bucks county, against Thomas Mitchell, Stephen H. Tyng, Jacob Lex, and Andrew D. Cash, for a conspiracy, &c. be, and the same is hereby removed to the court of oyer and terminer of Montgomery county for trial, and that the president judge of the third judicial district of Pennsylvania, be, and he is hereby authorized to preside at the trial of the same, instead of the president judge of the seventh district, and that the same be proceeded in to trial, verdict and judgment, as fully in the said court of oyer and terminer of Montgomery county before the said president judge of the third judicial district, and one or more of the associate judges of Montgomery county, as it otherwise would in the county of Bucks; and that the said president judge of the third judicial district may make all necessary orders and appointments for holding a court or courts, and summoning jurors to try the same; and in case any future indictment or indictments shall be found in the county of Bucks against the said defendants, or any of them, or arising out of the transactions which gave rise to the said indictments hereby removed, the same shall be certified and removed to the court of oyer and terminer of Montgomery county or trial, to be there proceeded in as is hereinbefore provided, in relation to the prosecution now pending.
