RESOLUTION

Relative to the election of County Treasurer, in Philadelphia county.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,* That so much of the forty-second section of an act passed the sixteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, entitled "an act regulating election districts, and for other purposes," as provides that the election of a county treasurer for the city and county of Philadelphia, shall take place on the first Monday in June, be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as regards the election of said treasurer in eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and that the county board are hereby authorized to elect the said treasurer on the second Wednesday in April next. *Provided,* that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to abridge the time for which the present county treasurer was elected.
