RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Governor to borrow money.

Temporary
loan to pay
troops

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met,* That the governor, be, and he hereby is authorized to borrow on the credit of the state, on temporary loan, for a period of not more than one year, and at a rate of interest not exceeding five per cent, any sum of money that may be found necessary to pay the volunteers, and all other claims legally allowed under the resolution passed by the senate and house of representatives providing for the pay, emoluments, perquisites, and expenses of the volunteer troops of the first and eleventh divisions of the Pennsylvania militia, recently in the service of this commonwealth.
