## RESOLUTION

Authorizing the State Treasurer to refund certain money to Stephen Shores.

WHEREAS, Stephen Shores, on the eighth day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, paid into the treasury of this commonwealth the sum of ten dollars patent fees on a certain tract of land situate in Bradford county. AND WHEREAS, The same sum of ten dollars, as patent fees on the same tract of land, was again paid by him and received into the said treasury, through mistake, on the eleventh day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty seven: Preamble

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,* That the treasurer of this commonwealth, be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to the said Stephen Shores, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ten dollars, with interest, from the time the same was so paid and received through mistake.
