RESOLUTION

Granting aid to the Johnstown and Ligonier Turnpike Road Company.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met,* That the governor be, and he is hereby authorized and required to subscribe stock to the Johnstown and Ligonier turnpike road company to the amount of four thousand dollars, which shall constitute the commonwealth a stockholder in said company to that amount, on equal footing with other stockholders of said company.
