RESOLUTION

Relative to the Mercer and Great Bend Turnpike Road.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met,* That it shall be lawful for the commissioners appointed to receive subscriptions for stock to the Mercer and Great Bend turnpike road company, to open books for subscription of the stock of said company on the first Monday in August next, or at any time within three months thereafter, but on failure to open the books on the day aforesaid, at least twenty days notice of the time and place of opening the same shall be given in one or more of the newspapers printed in the county of Mercer.

RESOLVED, That it shall be lawful for a majority of the stockholders of said company, after receiving their charter of incorporation, to determine by vote whether they will construct a turnpike road or a rail road between the points designated in the act to which this is a supplement, or which may be fixed by the president and managers pursuant thereto, and in case of determining to construct a rail road, the tolls to be taken thereon shall be determined by the board of managers. *Provided,* The same shall not exceed the tolls for a like distance on the Pennsylvania rail road.
