A N A C T

To extend the boundaries of the borough of Martinsburg, in Bedford county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same: That the boundaries of the borough of ^{Borough Mar-} Martinsburg, in Bedford county, be extended as follows, viz: ^{tinsburg—} beginning at a post near the house of Frederick Nicodemus, ^{boundaries ex-} now occupied by George Nicodemus, where the present boundary commences; thence south twenty-two degrees, west two hundred perches to a post; thence north sixty-five degrees, west two hundred perches to a post; thence north twenty-two degrees, east two hundred perches to a post, a corner of the present boundary; and thence with the same south sixty-five degrees, east two hundred perches to the place of beginning.
