Making compensation to William McCoy and William C. Leavensworth for expenses incurred and services rendered as agents for the commonwealth in discovering lands, late the estate of John Nicholson and Peter Baynton, and on which the commonwealth has a lien.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same:* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to William M'Cooy, or order, one thousand five hundred dollars, and to William C. Leavensworth, or order, two thousand dollars, in full, for expenses incurred and services rendered by them, respectively, as agents of the commonwealth in discovering lands and titles thereto, late the estate of John Nicholson and Peter Baynton, and on which the commonwealth holds a lien; said sums to be reimbursed to the commonwealth with lawful interest out of the proceeds of the sale of said lands.
