

LAWS PASSED SESSION 1841.

AN ACT

Erecting a new Township in Clinton county, to be called Crawford, and erecting the same into a separate election district.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same:* That all that part of Limestone township (formerly in Lycoming county,) which now, by the erection of Clinton county, is made part of said Clinton county, be and the same is hereby erected into a separate township, to be called Crawford, and also into a separate election district; and that the general elections of said district shall be held at the house of Philip Showers.

Limestone township, Clinton co., changed to Crawford township, and made a separate election district. Gen'l election where held.
