## A N A C T

Supplementary to an act entitled, "An act to incorporate the President, Managers and Company, of the Bustleton and Sommerton Turnpike road company," passed the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty.

*SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and managers of Bustleton and Sommerton turnpike road company, shall have the privilege of extending their turnpike road to the Buck tavern, in the township of Southampton, in the county of Bucks, and they are hereby authorized to alter or change the bed of said road, any place between the Buck tavern and the borough of Frankford, where it shall intersect the Frankford and Bristol turnpike road, near the Rocks, by first compromising with the owners of property through which such alteration may pass, or if the parties cannot agree, by paying such damages as shall be awarded by a jury appointed by the proper court.
