## AN ACT

To repeal so much of the act passed the twentieth day of March, eighteen hundred and forty, entitled "An act to encourage more effectually the destruction of wolves and panthers in the counties of Luzerne, Susquehanna, Wayne, Pike, Jefferson, M'Kean, Tioga, Potter, Bradford, and Monroe, and for other purposes," as relates to the counties of Jefferson and M'Kean.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, so much of the act passed the twentieth day of March, eighteen hundred and forty, entitled "An act to encourage more effectually the destruction of wolves and panthers, in the counties of Luzerne, Susquehanna, Wayne, Pike, Jefferson, M'Kean, Tioga, Potter, Bradford and Monroe, and for other purposes," as relates to the counties of Jefferson and M'Kean, be and the same is hereby repealed. Part of former act repealed.

SECTION 2. And that the provisions of the act referred to in the title of this act, be and the same are hereby extended to the county of Warren. Provisions of former act extended to Warren co.
