## A N A C T

Supplementary to the act entitled, "A supplement to an act entitled an act to incorporate the city of Pittsburg," passed the tenth day of March, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, and for other purposes.

Certain compensation to recorder of Pittsburg and Philad'a repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as authorizes the recorder of the city of Pittsburg to receive out of the State treasury the sum of six hundred dollars per annum, as a compensation for his services, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the act entitled, "A supplement to the act entitled an act to incorporate the city of Philadelphia," passed the twenty-seventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that hereafter no salary or compensation shall be allowed or paid by the Commonwealth, to the recorder of the city of Philadelphia.

## A N A C T

To enable the heirs and representatives of Oliver Ormsby, late of St. Clair township, Allegheny county, deceased, to make partition of their estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the orphans' court of the county of Alle-

gheny, be and it is hereby empowered, to make partition Orphans' according to law, among the heirs and representatives of Oliver court empowered to make Ormsby, late of St. Clair township, and county aforesaid, of that portion only which is clear of disbute, of the real estate partition of that part clear of disbute. situate in the county aforesaid, of which said Oliver Ormsby died seized.

SECTION 2. That the orphans' court of the county aforesaid, Further partition be and it is hereby empowered, to make a further partition according to law, among the said heirs and representatives of Oliver Ormsby, at such time as shall be desired by the said heirs and representatives, or by any of them, of all that portion which is now in litigation of the said real estate, or any part thereof, which shall be legally adjudged to belong to the said heirs and representatives.

## AN ACT

For the relief of John Stewart and others, soldiers, and Sarah Sebring and others, widows of soldiers, of the revolutionary and Indian wars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same:* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Stewart of Erie county, or to his order, forty dollars as a gratuity in full for his services rendered during the Indian war. Relief of soldiers & widows of soldiers in Erie co.

SECTION 2. That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required, to pay to Sarah Sebring, of Luzerne Luzerne co. county, Sarah Earle of Allegheny county, and Marianna Allegheny co. Smith of Northampton county, widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars each during life, payable half-yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.
