A N A C T

To authorize Charles S. Bradford, trustee of Mary M. Brackenridge of the city of Allegheny, to sell and convey a certain ground rent.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Charles S. Bradford of the city of Pittsburg, trustee for the separate use of Mary M. Brackenridge, wife of Alexander Brackenridge, of the city of Allegheny, and for the children of the said Alexander and Mary, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey, with the consent of the said Mary, and with the approbation of the court of common pleas of the county of Allegheny, a certain annual ground rent of one hundred and fifty dollars, charged on a part of lot number four hundred and eight, in Wood's plan of Pittsburg; and further, to invest the proceeds of such sale in such real estate or such securities as shall be approved of by the said court, for the same uses and upon the same trusts as the said ground rent is now held: *Provided however,* That before executing the power hereby granted, the said Charles S. Bradford shall give sufficient security to be approved of by the said court, for the faithful execution of the said power.

A S U P P L E M E N T

To an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Stafford Coal Company," passed the third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in Gen-*

eral Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time in which the Stafford coal company is required to complete its railroad, is hereby extended to the first day of September, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, and that said company is hereby authorized to apply any portion of the one hundred thousand dollars capital stock or loan which it is authorized to create for the purpose of constructing said road, and which may remain unexpended after the completion of the same, to the construction of other *May construct other railroads* railroads which it is hereby authorized to construct, leading from future openings of coal mines in its lands, to connect with any neighboring railroad or railroads of other incorporated companies, as the same may from time to time be found expedient or necessary, with the same powers and immunities and subject to the same restrictions, terms and conditions, as relate to the first mentioned railroad, excepting as is herein otherwise provided.

AN ACT

To authorize the Auditor General to issue Certificates of State Stock to Samuel and James Corrie.

Auditor general to issue new certificates of state stock to Samuel & James Corrie.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall and may be lawful for the Auditor General, to cause to be issued new certificates of debt of this Commonwealth, to Samuel Corrie and James Corrie, for their proportional share of a certificate formerly issued, and numbered two thousand and eighty-six of the State five per cent stock, redeemable in one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, in lieu of said certificate number two thousand and eighty-six, on satisfactory proof being made that such certificate is of record in the court of first instance of civil jurisdiction of the Island of Trinidad, and as such record cannot be taken therefrom, and
