AN ACT

Changing the time of holding the January term of the several courts of Tioga county, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same:* That the January terms and sessions of the courts of Tioga county, in this state, shall commence on the third Monday in the month of January in each year hereafter, and continue thence for the period now established, instead of commencing on the second Monday of said month as at present provided by law.

Time for holding courts in Tioga county changed.

SECTION 2. That the orphans' court of the county of Washington are authorized and empowered to appoint a guardian to take charge of the person and property of Sarah Bailey, a deaf and dumb person, and that said court shall require such bail of said guardian, as in their opinion, the case shall require, who shall be subject to all laws, to which guardians of minors are subject by the laws of this Commonwealth.

Washington co. orp. court to app't guardian for Sarah Bailey.

SECTION 3. That all that part of the township of Deerfield, in the county of Tioga, which has been taken from the township of Elkland, in said county, and annexed to the said township of Deerfield, shall be and the same hereby is annexed to

Tioga co. part of Deerfield sp. annexed

to the 3d election district. and made part of the third election district of the said county, composed of the township of Deerfield aforesaid.

Portions of a certain act extended to Tioga, Potter and M'Kean SECTION 4. That the sixth and seventh sections of the act of the eighth of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty, entitled an act to incorporate the Lehigh company for the insurance of the lives of horses and the detection of horse thieves, and for other purposes, be and the same are extended to the counties of Tioga, Potter and McKean.

West. Bank of Phila. authorized to change location.

SECTION 5. The president, directors and company of the Western Bank of Philadelphia, now located on the west side of Ninth street, shall be and they are hereby authorized to remove or change the location of said bank to any point west of Delaware Fifth street in said city, any thing in any former law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Time of holding courts in the 11th judicial district changed.

SECTION 6. That from and after the first day of April next, the several courts in the eleventh judicial district of this Commonwealth, shall be held as follows to wit: In the county of Susquehanna on the third Mondays of April, August, November and January, to continue two weeks; in the county of Wayne on the Mondays succeeding the courts in Susquehanna county, to continue one week; in the county of Monroe, on the Tuesday succeeding the courts in Wayne county, to continue one week: in the county of Pike on the Tuesdays succeeding the courts in the county of Monroe, to continue one week: *Provided*, That the courts in Susquehanna county for the second week may be dispensed with, as often as in the opinion of the judges thereof, the business of said courts shall not require the holding of the same, and all writs, rules, process and notices heretofore issued and returnable to the next April and May terms of said courts, are hereby made returnable to the days severally above specified for holding the next April and May terms: *Provided*, That any law which is hereby altered and supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Wayne co. attached to northern dist. of supreme court SECTION 7. That from and after the passage of this act, the county of Wayne shall be and it hereby is attached to the northern district of the supreme court, and that all writs of error and certiorari, and all appeals and proceedings now depending in the eastern district of said court, or which shall be depending therein, prior to the second Monday in July next from the court of said county of Wayne, shall be removed into the said northern district for determination.

Com. Wayne co. author'd to borro' money to erect public buildings.

SECTION 8. That the commissioners of Wayne county and their successors in office be and they are hereby authorized to borrow any sum of money not exceeding ten thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting new county buildings, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent per annum, and to pledge the faith

of the said county for the reimbursement of any loan or loans that may be negotiated under the authority of this act.

A N A C T

To establish an Asylum for the Insane of this Commonwealth.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That there shall be erected as soon as conveniently may be, upon some suitable site to be determined and obtained as is hereinafter provided, a public asylum for the reception and relief of the insane of this Commonwealth. Asylum established.

SECTION 2. That three suitable persons shall be appointed and commissioned by the Governor, to select and purchase a site for said asylum, and to contract for and superintend the building thereof: *Provided,* That the persons so appointed shall receive no compensation for their services, but their necessary expenses to be paid in the manner hereinafter prescribed. Gov. to appoint 3 persons to select site.

SECTION 3. That the site and necessary grounds for said asylum, shall not cost more than ten thousand dollars, and the building shall be planned and arranged for the accommodation of three hundred patients and the necessary officers, and with reference to the future enlargement of the same. Cost of site, &c, limited

SECTION 4. That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized to borrow on the credit of the Commonwealth, at such times and in such sums as may be required by the provisions of this act, the sum of one hundred and twenty thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum. Gov. to borrow \$120,000 Interest. The said loan shall be styled the loan for the Pennsylvania insane asylum, and shall be reimbursable at any time after the expiration of five years, and shall be transferable as other loans of this Commonwealth are, and the interest thereof shall Reimbursable Transferable.
