## AN ACT

Supplementary to an act passed the eighth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, entitled "An act to incorporate the Pittsburg Saving Fund Company, and the Carlisle Saving Fund Company."

- SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the powers and privileges granted to the Pittsburg Saving Fund company, by the act to which this is a supplement and the supplement thereto, be and the same are hereby extended until the first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.
- SECTION 2.** From and after the passage of this act, the corporate name and style of the Pittsburg Saving Fund company shall, and the same is hereby changed and altered, to "The Farmer's Deposit Bank of Pittsburg."
- SECTION 3.** The Farmer's Deposit Bank of Pittsburg shall be, and the said company are hereby authorized, to increase their stock and deposits to the amount of five hundred thousand dollars; and the clause of the sixth section of the act of the thirty-first of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven, limiting the capital stock and amount of deposits in said company, to two hundred thousand dollars, be and the same is hereby repealed: *Provided however,* That the said institution shall not be permitted to issue any certificate payable on demand or otherwise, in the nature of a bank note.
- SECTION 4.** The duties appertaining to and devolving upon the treasurer of the said company, are hereby transferred to and vested in a cashier, who shall give bond in the same amount, and with the same number of sureties heretofore required of the said treasurer; and he shall perform all the duties heretofore attached to the offices of treasurer and secretary to said company; and the offices of treasurer and secretary of said company are hereby abolished.
- SECTION 5.** The treasurer for the time being, at the date of the passage of this act, shall assume and perform the duties of cashier of said company, until the next regular election.
- SECTION 6.** The stockholders of said company, shall convene in May next, and annually thereafter, and elect by ballot one person for president, one person for cashier, and six directors, who shall continue in office for one year: *Provided*

however, That no person shall be elected who is not a member of said company; and that all vacancies occasioned by death, resignation, removal, or refusal to serve, shall be supplied in such manner, as said company may by their by-laws and ordinances hereafter direct.

SECTION 7. So much of any act as is hereby altered or repealed, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. That the legislature hereby reserves the power to alter, revoke or annul the provisions of this act, whenever in their opinion it may be injurious to the citizens of the Commonwealth, in such manner however, that no injustice shall be done to the corporators.

## A N A C T

To incorporate the Lancaster County Mutual Insurance Company, and to extend the Mechanics' Lien Law to the county of Clinton.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Thomas G. Henderson, Samuel Duffield, William Noble, Henry F. Slaymaker, Ferree Brinton, Henry Eckert, Christian Umble, James G. Henderson, and William Henderson, and all other persons who may hereafter associate with them in the manner hereinafter prescribed, shall be and are hereby constituted and declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the name, style and title of the Lancaster County Mutual Insurance company, and by the same name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be able to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, in all courts of record or elsewhere; and to purchase, receive, have, hold and enjoy to them and their successors, lands, tenements, rents, annuities, franchises and hereditaments, goods and chattles, of what kind soever, and choses in action, and the same to sell and dispose of from time to time: *Provided*, That the clear yearly value or income
