A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "A further supplement to the act entitled 'An act authorizing the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the bank of the river Susquehanna, opposite Harrisburg, to Pittsburg.'"

- SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the stockholders of the Greensburg and Pittsburg turnpike road company shall hereafter, at the same time and place of the election of president, managers and treasurer, also elect two stockholders not being managers or officers of said company, to be called auditors, who shall annually, in the month of January, upon a day and place to be appointed by them, and of which they shall give due notice to the president, managers and treasurer of the said company, audit and settle the accounts of the said turnpike road company, and for that purpose shall have authority to inspect and examine the books and papers of the said company, and the said auditors shall immediately thereafter publish a correct statement of the said accounts in one public newspaper printed in the city of Pittsburg, and also in one published in the town of Greensburg; and if any officer, manager, gate keeper or stockholder shall neglect or refuse to produce and give up to the said auditors, when called upon and demanded by them, any book, account, voucher or paper belonging to the said company, he shall be liable for and pay a penalty of fifty dollars, to be recovered in like manner as debts of that amount are recoverable by the laws of this Commonwealth.
- SECTION 2.** That the said auditors, in the annual settlement of the accounts of said company, shall allow to the president and managers such amount as may be fixed by the by-laws of said company for every day such president and managers may have been actually and unavoidably employed and engaged in the business of the said company, and such allowance shall be in full for such services; nor shall the said president, managers or officers of the said company be permitted to pass the gates of the said company, free of toll, unless when actually engaged upon the business and affairs of the said company.
- SECTION 3.** That the elections of the said company shall hereafter be held at such toll house belonging to the said company, as shall be situated nearest to the point on their turnpike

road equidistant from the city of Pittsburg and the town of Greensburg, and that no stockholder residing in the county of Allegheny, or the county of Westmoreland, shall be permitted to vote by proxy.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this act shall not go into effect until they are accepted by a majority of the stockholders, at the annual meeting which shall be held next after the passage hereof. Provisions—

A N A C T

To Incorporate the President, Managers and Company of the Union Turnpike Road Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That James M'Girk and William Bagshaw, of the county of Centre, and Josiah W. Smith, Alexander B. Reed, and John Stikes, of the county of Clearfield, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things hereinafter mentioned, that is to say: they or any two of them, shall, on or before the first day of August next, procure two books, and in each of them enter as follows: "We, whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the president and managers of the Union Turnpike road company the sum of twenty-five dollars for every share of stock set opposite to our respective names, in such manner and proportions, and at such times as shall be determined by the president and managers of said company, in pursuance of an act of the general assembly of this Commonwealth, entitled an act to incorporate the president and managers of the Union turnpike road company.
