## AN ACT

For the relief of Joseph Drake, senior, and others, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian Wars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority*

*of the same,* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Joseph Drake, senior, Jacob Lobar and Jacob Etter, of Monroe county, George Ream, of Lancaster county, Robert Hanna and Margaret Callahan, of Westmoreland county, Parmelia Gilbert, of Greene county, Catharine Wertz, of Berks county, Elizabeth Herring, of Bedford county, Barbara Mitman, of York county, Arnold Martin, of Erie county, Catharine Foster, of Warren county, Margaret Robison, of Allegheny county, Sarah Patton, of Philadelphia county, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary and Indian wars, or to their respective orders, forty dollars, immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars each, during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.

SECTION 2. That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Barbary Shannon, of Crawford county, Hugh Kerr, of Mercer county, to John King, of Armstrong county, and to John Foster, of Crawford county, soldiers and the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary and Indian wars, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each, immediately, as a gratuity, and in full for military services; the foregoing pensions and gratuities to be paid in conformity with existing laws.
