A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act authorizing the Governor to Incorporate the Mahoning, Kittanning and Freeport Turnpike Road Company, and for other purposes," passed on the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the thirty-third section of an act of assembly, entitled "an act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Mahoning, Kittanning and Freeport turnpike road company, and for other purposes," approved on the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, as fixes the termination of the Waterstreet and Clearfield road, at a point on the Snow Shoe and Packersvills turnpike road, east of John Kyler's, in Clearfield county, be and is hereby altered, and the town of Phillipsburg is hereby made the point at which the said Waterstreet and Clearfield turnpike is to terminate, and so much of the said thirty-third section as is hereby altered or supplied, is hereby repealed, and that James Clarke, Thomas Weston, J. K. McCahan, Benjamin Patton, junior, be and are hereby appointed commissioners for said road, to act in conjunction with those named in the act to which this is a supplement.
