That the said Allegheny coal company shall have power and authority to construct such railroad or railroads as may be deemed necessary, with one or more tracks, from any point or points on their lands to the Maryland state line, in the direction of Cumberland. A SUPPLEMENT

To an Act entitled "An act to Incorporate a Company to make a Turnpike Road from the borough of Blairsville, in Indiana county, to Mount Pleasant, in Westmoreland county," passed the tenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby altered and amended, so as to authorize the Governor to incorporate a separate company, under the style and title of "the Farmers' and Mechanics' Turnpike Road Company of Westmoreland County," and that the said company be authorized to make a turnpike road from some point on the Pennsylvania canal, within one mile of the Broad Fording, on the Conemaugh river, to a point on the Stoystown and Greensburg turnpike road, at the dwelling house of Alexander Johnston, so as in the opinion of the president and managers of the said company, to combine among other advantages, the most level and best ground for said road and the shortest distance.

SECTION 2. That the said company shall cause the said road to be made not less than forty nor more than sixty feet wide, and at least eighteen feet of which shall be artificial road. And the said company shall have like powers and privileges

as are granted to the Stoystown and Greensburg turnpike road company, and be subject to like penalties and restrictions of said company, as are enjoined by an act of assembly passed the ninth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and fourteen. Powers, privileges, restrictions, &c

SECTION 3. That Alexander Johnston, John Rhey, Samuel Wallace, John S. Watterson, Adam Beamer, George Rhey, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, to open books, and receive subscriptions to the stock of the said company, and when ten or more persons shall have subscribed fifty or more shares, it shall be the duty of the said commissioners, or a majority of them, to certify the same to the Governor, who shall thereupon incorporate the said subscribers and others thereafter becoming subscribers to the said stock, into a company, by the style and title as aforesaid; and the said company shall be allowed three years to commence the said road in, and seven years thereafter to complete it. SECTION 4. The act to which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby revived, except so much thereof as is hereby altered or supplied, which is hereby repealed. Revival and repeal

SECTION 5. That so much of the third section of an act entitled "An act changing the time of holding the courts in the fourteenth judicial district, and for other purposes," passed the sixth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, as raises the pay of county commissioners, and auditors, in the county of Buck, is hereby repealed, and said officers shall be paid the same as before the passing of that act.
