## AN ACT

Relative to the Union Academy of Doylestown, in the county of Bucks.

Part of former  
law repealed

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same;* That the seventh and eighth sections of the act of assembly, passed the sixteenth April, one thousand eight hundred and forty, entitled "A supplement to an act entitled an act for the organization of a new county, from parts of Venango and Armstrong to be called Clarion, passed the eleventh day of March, one thousand eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and for other purposes" be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** That the title to the lot of land and appurtenances conveyed by Charles Meredith, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, to certain trustees, to be held in trust for the use of the "Union Academy of Doylestown," in the county of Bucks, be and the same is hereby transferred to and vested in the trustees of said academy, and their successors in office elected in pursuance of the provisions contained in the act incorporating said academy, passed fifteenth April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, to have and to hold the same for the uses, trusts and purposes mentioned in the deed of trust above mentioned.
