RESOLUTION

To suspend for a limited period an act supplementary to the various acts relating to Tavern Licenses, and for other purposes.

Former act suspended **RESOLVED, By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met,** That the act entitled "An act supplementary to the various acts relating to tavern licenses, passed the twenty-seventh day of March, eighteen hundred and forty-one," be and the same is hereby suspended in its operation, until the first day of July, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.

Duty of clerk court quarter sessions to publish list of licensed inn-keepers **RESOLVED,** That it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court of quarter sessions of the city and county of Philadelphia, immediately after any term of said court at which inns or taverns shall have been licensed, to publish once a week for one month, in two daily newspapers, and also to fill and keep up in his office a list of the names of all persons who shall have been licensed by said court to keep such inns or taverns, and, far as the same can be done, designate the particular place where such inns or taverns are situated, the expense of such publications not exceeding three cents per name, to be paid out of the county treasury.
