## RESOLUTION

Authorizing a Loan.

*RESOLVED, By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,*

That the several banks of this Commonwealth, if other means should fail, be and they are hereby required to loan to the Commonwealth, the amount prescribed by the several acts of assembly regulating or incorporating the same, or such part thereof as the Governor may require. And the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and required to give notice to said banks, and negotiate said loans upon the terms contained in said acts, and direct the auditor general and state treasurer to issue certificates of state stock to the said banks respectively, for the amount thus loaned by each, upon the terms stipulated in the said acts. The amount thus loaned, to be paid to and vested in the commissioners of the internal improvement fund, to be applied by them to the payment of interest on the public debt.
