## RESOLUTION

For the relief of John Doll, of Lehigh county.

**RESOLVED,** *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Lichtenwalter, of Upper Macungie township, Lehigh county, in trust for John Doll, of said county, or to his order, the annuity to which he is entitled in pursuance of the act of the fifth March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, entitled "An act for the relief of sundry soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war, and that so much of any act or acts as directed the payment of the said annuity to John Fogel or Solomon Fogel, or any other person or persons be and the same is hereby repealed.
