## AN ACT

Supplementary to an act entitled "an act to divide the township of Germantown into two distinct Wards," and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the upper and lower wards of Germantown township, county of Philadelphia, shall be separate and distinct election districts, and shall each annually elect separately at their ward and township elections one constable, and when necessary, one justice of the peace, one supervisor of roads, one assessor, and when necessary, two assistant assessors, one town clerk, three settlers of accounts, three overseers of the poor, and the number of school directors provided by the thirty-second section of an act entitled "an act relative to the election of borough and township officers and for other purposes," approved the seventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and forty. To elect separately constables justices supervisors &c

SECTION 2. That so much of the act entitled "an act to divide the township of Germantown into two distinct wards, and for other purposes," approved the twenty-seventh day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty, which is inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the sixty-ninth section of an act entitled "an act regulating election districts and for other purposes," approved the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty, be and the same is hereby repealed.
