AN ACT

Authorizing the Commissioners of Westmoreland and Allegheny counties to settle the accounts of Henry Alter, William Greer, and John M. Laird, for services rendered in locating a State road in said counties and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of Westmoreland and Allegheny counties are hereby authorized and required to settle the accounts of Henry Alter, William Greer, and John M. Laird, in such manner as to allow to them a reasonable compensation for the payment of one target man and one axe man by them employed in locating a state road from Logan's ferry, in Allegheny county, to intersect the new graded road from Greensburg, Westmoreland county, to Chaffants on Turtle creek, at or near the farm of Mr. Remery, five miles west of Greensburg; and also a reasonable compensation for making three drafts of said road, and all other necessary expenses by them incurred in settling their accounts with said commissioners, and payment made by the county treasurer proportioned to distance said road passes through each county.

SECTION 2. That so much of the third section of the act, of the first of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation of boroughs" as requires applications for the incorporations of boroughs to be laid before the Grand Jury, be and the same is hereby repealed as respects Westmoreland county, in the case of an application for the incorporation of West Newton, in said county, and the court of quarter sessions of said county is hereby authorized to incorporate West Newton, into a borough on application at their first term, if the said court think proper so to do.
