AN ACT

Supplementary to an act passed the sixteenth day of June, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, entitled "an act to authorize suit to be brought on the official bond of William B. Mitchell, State Superintendent."

WHEREAS, The alley referred to in the following act has been rendered useless as a public thoroughfare by the occupancy of Washington street, by the Pennsylvania canal: *And* ^{Preamble} *whereas*, the ground over which said alley passes, is now, with the general consent of the owners of ground fronting thereon used as a canal basin.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That a certain alley in the city of Pittsburg, twenty feet wide, and extending from Wayne to Washington streets, between Penn and Liberty street, being the same alley which was authorized by the will of the late John Woods deceased, be and the same is hereby exempted from the provisions of the ninth section of an act passed the tenth day of June eighteen hundred and thirty-six, entitled "an act to authorize suit to be brought upon the official bond of William B. Mitchell, late superintendent."
