## A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "an act to graduate lands on which money is due and unpaid to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the provisions of the act, entitled "an act to graduate lands on which the money is due and unpaid to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania," passed the tenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, shall be and the same are hereby continued in force until the tenth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, and no longer. Former act continued

SECTION 2. That the time for patenting the in and out lots in the towns of Erie, Waterford, Beaver, Franklin and Warren, authorized to be appraised by the fifth section of the act entitled "an act empowering the burgess and town council of the borough of Erie to borrow money, and to supply the said borough with water, and for other purposes," passed the thirteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, be extended until the tenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, and no longer. Patenting lots in Erie Waterford Beaver Franklin and Warren extended
