## A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "an act regulating Lateral Rail Roads."

**Certain acts to extend to Tioga and Columbia counties**

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the several provisions of the act entitled "an act regulating lateral rail-roads," passed May fifth, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, and of the several supplements thereunto, shall extend to the counties of Tioga and Columbia.

## A N A C T

To prevent the destruction of Fish in the Allegheny, Monongahela and Ohio Rivers, and for other purposes.

**Fishing in certain rivers prohibited**

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the first day of May next, it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to catch fish in the Allegheny, Monongahela, and Ohio rivers, with a seine or seines, exceeding twenty feet in length in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, during the months of May, June, July, August, and September.

**Penalty**

**SECTION 2.** Any person offending against the provisions of this act, shall, on conviction thereof before any justice of the peace in said Commonwealth, pay a fine of fifty dollars for
