A N A C T

For the relief of James Henderson.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Canal Commissioners be authorized to examine the claim of James Henderson, late a contractor for lock number thirty-one, of the Shenango Line Erie Extension, and make such allowances for extra work and materials, and for the alteration of the original plan of said lock by direction of the engineer, as may be just and equitable: *Provided,* That no allowance be made on account of any rise or fall in price of provisions, and draw their warrant on the State Treasury for the amount, if any, so by them awarded in favor of said contractor, and the Treasurer is hereby required to pay the same out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated by law.
