SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "an act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Lycoming Navigation, Rail Road and Coal Company," passed the ninth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight.

Name changed

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the name of the "Lycoming Navigation, Rail Road and Coal Company," be and the same is hereby changed to the Red Run Coal Company, and by the said name, style, and title of the Red Run Coal Company, shall have all the privileges incident to the said corporation, and the said company is hereby released from the construction of any rail road other than such roads as shall be found necessary for carrying on the business of transporting coal from their mines and other purposes, and the charter of said company shall not be forfeited by reason of any omission heretofore, to comply with the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, and the said act and charter shall be and continue in force until the first Monday of December, one thousand eight hundred and sixty.
