A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act, to enable Hardman Philips, to receive certain conveyances, and grant and convey certain lands.

Preamble

WHEREAS, the said Hardman Philips, since the passing of the act, to which this is a supplement, has received from Sophia Philips the widow of his late brother Henry Philips, deceased, her interest in the lands originally owned by his father and brother, which remain unsold, in the state of Pennsylvania, and the said Hardman Philips desires to sell and dispose of the lands. Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the title of Sophia Philips, which is now in Hardman Philips is hereby confirmed as fully and effectually as if the said Hardman Philips had been a citizen of the United States, and it shall and may be lawful for the said Hardman Philips, to grant, bargain and sell the said estate, in the county of Centre, and elsewhere in Pennsylvania, in fee simple or otherwise, as if he was a citizen of the United States, and all disability arising from his want of citizenship touching his holding and selling the said estate is hereby removed.
