AN ACT

Authorizing the sale of certain real estate held by certain Congregations of the German Reformed Presbyterian Church, in the county of Perry.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Henry Hipple, trustee of Zion's Church, John Ritter, trustee of Lebanon Church, Jacob Shively, trustee of St. Peter's Church, William Allbright, trustee of Fishing Creek Church, and Peter Smith, trustee of Christ's Church, in the county of Perry, be and they are hereby authorized to sell at public or private sale a certain tract of land situate in Tyron township in the county of Perry, containing fourteen acres and twenty-eight perches of land more or less, now held in trust for the use of the said five several churches and by their deed convey the same to the purchaser or purchasers in fee simple.
