A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act graduating the duties upon wholesale dealers and retailers of merchandize, and prescribing the mode of issuing licenses and collecting duties," passed the seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the constables of each township, borough or ward, of the city and county of Philadelphia, and each county in this commonwealth, shall, in addition to the duties prescribed by the second section of an act, entitled "An Act graduating the duties upon wholesale dealers and retailers of merchandize, and prescribing the mode of issuing licenses and collecting duties," passed the seventh of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty, give written or printed notice at least five days before the day of appeal fixed by the judges of the court of common pleas and the commissioners of said county, to every wholesale dealer and retailer of merchandize within their respective township, borough or ward, of the amount or sum for which he stands rated, and of the time and place of such appeal.
