AN ACT

Authorizing the Canal Commissioners to settle the claims of Cummins, Johnston and Corryell.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to examine into the claim for work done by Cummins, Johnston and Corryell, on sections number thirty-one and thirty-seven, on the Sinnemahoning extension of the West Branch canal, and to settle the same on just and equitable terms, and if anything shall be found due to them, or either of them, he or they shall be entitled to a credit for the amount, on the books of the auditor general, bearing interest at six per centum per annum from the date of the entry.
