AN ACT

To incorporate the Dauphin County Mutual Insurance company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Jacob M. Haldeman, Benjamin Parke, John Fox, John C. Bugher, Samuel Holman, Joseph W. Cake, J. J. C. Cantine, Simon Cameron, Gen. William Clark, Henry Buehler, John P. Leebrick, Henry M. Bayard, Solomon Shindle, Michael Whitley, Jacob Seal, Christian Eberman, and all other persons who may hereafter associate with them, in the manner hereinafter prescribed, shall be, and are hereby constituted and declared to be a body politic and corporate, under and by the name, style and title of the "Dauphin County Mutual Insurance company," and shall have all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same provisions of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed tenth February, eighteen hundred and forty-three, and this association shall confine its operations to the county of Dauphin, and shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer. The first thirteen named persons in this act shall constitute the first board of managers, to carry this act into effect.
