AN ACT

To repeal the act, entitled "An Act to encourage the destruction of foxes and wild cats, in the counties of Lebanon, Luzerne, Wayne, Pike, Monroe, Susquehanna and Tioga."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act, entitled "An Act to encourage the destruction of foxes and wild cats, in the counties of Lebanon, Luzerne, Wayne, Pike, Monroe, Susquehanna and Tioga," passed the sixteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as relates to the counties of Tioga, Luzerne and Wyoming.
