A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to legalize certain proceedings in the Court of Common Pleas of Adams county, and for other purposes."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the warrants issued by the commissioners of Northumberland county, to Samuel Awl, since deceased, for the collection of the taxes assessed in the town-ship of Augusta, in the county of Northumberland, for the years eighteen hundred and thirty-nine and eighteen hundred and forty, shall be good and effectual, for and during the term of two years, from the passage of this act, so as to authorize the Honorable George C. Welker and Gideon Leisenring, the bail of the said deceased, to the county commissioners, for the faithful collection of said taxes, to levy and collect the said taxes remaining due and unpaid, in the manner now provided by law.
