AN ACT

To extend and continue in force an act, entitled " An Act to authorize the Governor to incorporate a company to erect a bridge over the Allegheny river, at or near Sharpsburg, in Allegheny county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act, entitled " An Act to authorize the governor to incorporate a company to erect a bridge over the Allegheny river, at or near Sharpsburg, in Allegheny county," passed on the thirteenth day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, be extended and continued in the same force and effect, upon the same terms and conditions, and for the same length of time, from and after the passage of this act, as the act aforesaid had and did from the date of its enactment, except only that the number of shares of stock required to be subscribed, prior to the issue of letters patent to incorporate said company, be hereby reduced from six hundred to three hundred.
