AN ACT

To incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance company of Pottstown.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That John Thompson, George Richards, Henry Potts, Jonas Smith and William Mintzer of Montgomery county, James Wells, Samuel Williams, Owen Stover, Samuel Shaffer and William Price of Chester county, and Henry Arms and Christian Shaner of Berks county, and such other persons as may associate with them under the authority of this act, their successors or assigns, are hereby made a corporation by the name and style of "The Mutual Fire Insurance company of Pottstown," who shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three; and the first named thirteen persons in this act, shall constitute the first board of managers to carry this act into effect; and the business of this corporation shall be confined to the counties of Montgomery, Berks and Chester. This act shall continue in operation for the term of twenty years, and no longer.
